



FIRST AID LEVEL 2 - 3 (incl CPR & AED)

Description

This course is designed to provide the participant who have already completed a First Aid Level 1 course and now wish to obtain additional knowledge and skills to understand and handle Trauma and basic Medical Emergencies. This is the highest level before progressing into a Professional Qualification.



This course is ideal for team leaders of Emergency Response Teams (ERTs) or Medical Teams, First Responders (Firemen/ Police), Security Professionals (Armed Response/ CPOs), Life Guards, Teachers and Education professionals and/ or someone wanting to enter into the medical profession be it me

Duration

Initial training: 4 days

Course Content / Modules Covered

The following subjects are covered in the training:

- Principles of first aid and safety;
- Emergency scene management.
- Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) & AED
- Wounds and bleeding.
- Musco-Skeletal Injuries – Fractures & Joints.
- Head and spinal injuries.
- Abdominal and crush injuries.
- Epilepsy & Fits, Asthma,
- Poisoning, bites and stings.
- Behavioural emergencies.
- Applied anatomy and physiology.
- Medico-Legal aspects
- Examination of the patient.
- Choking.
- Shock, unconsciousness fainting.
- Burns.
- Chest, Hand, Eye & Ear, Pelvic
- Medical Emergencies – Diabetes
- Anaphylaxis, Cardiac problems.
- Environmental illnesses injuries
- Emergency childbirth.
- Transport methods.

Entrance Requirement

First Aid Level 1 Certificate (valid and in date) Grade 9 educational level or equivalent – please submit proof with registration form.

Certification

Subject to assessment, all participants will be issued with a First Aid Level (3) Three certificate approved by the Department of Labour (Registration No: Cl622).

This qualification is valid for 3 years which can be renewed by attending a suitable 3-Day re-qualification course.

Public/ Open Courses

Public also known as open courses are scheduled in advance and are held at one of our **TRAINING VENUES**
